Megan started as a student at The Midland School at the age of 15. Her fondest memories revolve around her social circle, especially her first friend at Midland, Darius. Megan says building relationships motivates her to do her best.

These connections extend to her teachers, aides, and therapists, whom she credits for the tremendous strides she made during her educational years and beyond. Megan says two teachers in particular, Mrs. Tauscher and Mrs. Hickey, helped her achieve her goal of working at Midland.

"Mrs. Tauscher and I connected right away and she is always there for me," says Megan. "I always loved horticulture with Mrs. Hickey, too," she adds.

While participating in Midland's job training program, Megan's favorite sites were at a local pre-school and assisting in Midland's OT/PT program. Her supervisors say she was such an asset during her Midland OT/ PT internship that they had to make it a permanent thing.

Megan's dream of working at Midland came true in July of 2019. Now, working three days per week, Megan assists the therapists with lessons, activities, and a variety of clerical duties like copying, laminating, cleaning equipment, and setting up bulletin boards.

"Megan has an intuitive ability to help motivate students and keep them engaged," says Midland Occupational Therapist, Suzy Frank. "Her kindness, passion to help others, fun-loving spirit, creativity, and drive to keep learning and growing are all attributes that make her so special. She has truly been gan as part of the OT/PT team," she adds.

"As a staff member, Megan's patience and energy are boundless," says Midland's Supervisor, Karen Storm. "Her ideas are innovative

and her organizational skills are second to none. It is a joy to watch Megan interact with both our students and her co-workers. It is obvious that she enjoys working at Midland as much as we enjoy having her here."

Megan also finds time for interests outside of work. She especially enjoys gardening, baking, drawing, and helping in the community. Megan has a special affinity for helping through Buddy Ball-a nonprofit special needs athletic league.

"Midland prepared me to work here so I was sure I could do the job I was hired to do," says Megan, who enjoys seeing the students and staff each day. "I feel so much joy and excitement to come to work," she adds. "With Midland's help, I made my dreams come true!"
