Aidan L. Finds His Voice Using AAC Technology

Aidan L. has been a Midland student for the past six years. His family says the progress he's made during that time is a testament to The Midland School and its remarkable staff. They credit the collaborative efforts of the Occupational (OT), Physical (PT), and Speech Therapy teams for taking the initiative to identify, trial, and secure new Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC) technology that has further enhanced Aidan's quality of life and ability to communicate.

This past September, Aidan began to use the Neuronode Trilogy by Control Bionics which is a versatile and user-friendly communication device designed for individuals with complex speech and physical needs. It combines touch control, eye control, and EMG/Spatial control, offering a multimodal access method that can significantly increase communication speed and output.

"For Aidan, the goal was for him to make decisions for himself, answer questions, express his feelings, and exhibit control over his environment. He is sharp and choice is important," says his Speech-Language Pathologist (SLP), Ms. Fazio who explained how the team moved from trialing eye gaze, hats and even sweatbands before settling on a wristwatch as the best method for Aidan to control his device.

"We determined the Neuronode placed on Aidan's wrist using arm movement was the most efficient way to access his AAC

device," says his Occupational Therapist, Ms. Debra Gallagher. "We then focused on improving the endurance of this isolated movement, along with practicing using the AAC out of his wheelchair."

"Our focus in PT has been to support Aidan so he can access the school to the best of his abilities and achieve his utmost potential using his AAC device," says his Physical Therapist, Ms. Liliana Palma. "He works hard to actively strengthen his right arm into flexion and extension in multiple

positions to best use his device for school and home carryover."

Aidan frequently uses his device to select a stuffed animal of the day from a pre-loaded list on his personalized equipment. He also loves to discuss his favorite sports team, The New York Yankees, and his favorite person, his grandfather. "His favorite activity is to flex and extend his right forearm to knock down all the Yankees nemeses," adds Ms. Palma.

"Thanks to the Midland team's forward-thinking approach, Aidan was able to get this technology up and running just in time for his graduation this year," says Aidan's mother, Susan. "As we look ahead to the next phase of his adult life, it is reassuring that he will have this communication device in place to give him the ability to connect with others, advocate for himself, and express his needs."

"Aidan lights up the room with his smile and spreads joy to all," says his Teacher, Mrs. Giorello. "I am so happy to see him gain independence with the use of his communication device in the classroom!"

"It has been such a joy to see all the progress Aidan has made with his AAC device," says his Aide, Ms. Yajaira Gomez who is proud to see Aidan requesting needs and expressing feelings. "Aidan is a very social young man with a wonderful sense of humor. He loves interacting with us using his new voice and we cannot wait to see all his future progress!"

Dear Midland Community,

After a very long and often challenging winter, I feel it is safe to state that all of us here at Midland eagerly anticipate the onset of spring's warmer months and the projects that come along with it. This year, we are planning for more than a spring clean at the School – we are gearing up to break ground on an outdoor re-build!

I am pleased to announce that this summer Midland will construct a new ADA accessible playground. The 7,000 square foot playground will be located across from our current playground (Rainbow Land) adjacent to the picnic grove. Funding for the playground was made possible by a very generous grant from a private foundation coupled with other donations.

Additional funds are still needed to fully fund this project and ensure we can break ground this summer. Accordingly, all funds raised at the 11th Annual Move for Midland (see info on back fold of this newsletter), slated for May 30, will be dedicated to this project.

Once the new playground is complete, we will begin fundraising for an outdoor multi-disciplinary space to be in the current Rainbow Land space. Our vision for this space includes an outdoor classroom and picnic area, a performance stage, a music grotto, a tactile sensory garden, a mind-body studio, and a sensory area for calming and sensory support.

Each of these carefully designed components will come together to further enhance the multidisciplinary programs and services offered across all our programs at Midland. The planning by our collective team of educators, therapists, adult services, administrators and leaders at Midland has led to a reimagining of Rainbow Land with a focus on developing a contemporary playground that will meet the needs of our students and adults at Midland.

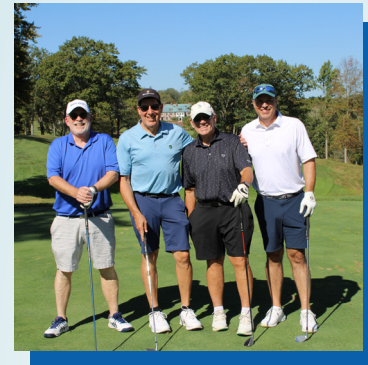
