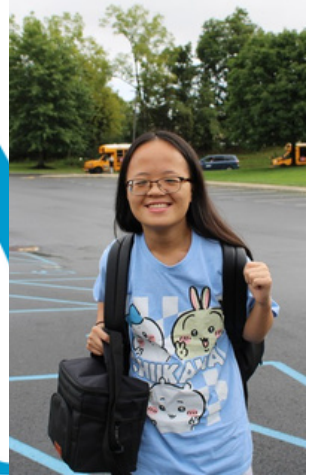
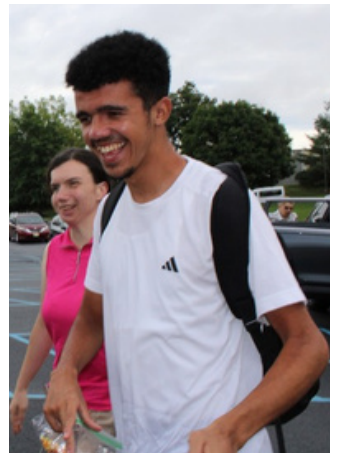

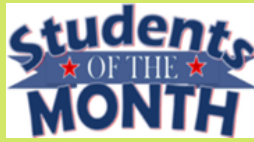

Why Is It Important?

Important Health Forms & Seasonal Health Reminders

As we prepare for the upcoming school year and the changing seasons, the Midland Nursing Department would like to thank you for your continued partnership in helping us provide safe, high-quality healthcare to every student.

Working together, families, healthcare providers, and Midland's nursing staff can help ensure that each student's individual health needs are understood and addressed from the very first day of attendance.

Why Is It Important to Return Health Forms Promptly?

To ensure that each student receives appropriate, individualized care, it is essential that all required medical documentation is submitted as soon as possible and before the start of the school year whenever applicable.

Having current health information allows our nursing staff to:

- ✓ Develop or update individualized healthcare plans
- ✓ Ensure medications and treatments are administered safely and accurately
- ✓ Respond appropriately during medical emergencies
- ✓ Communicate effectively with physicians, families, and school staff
- ✓ Meet New Jersey Department of Education and other applicable regulatory requirements

A Partnership in Your Child's Care

Every student is unique, and current medical information helps us provide the safest and most appropriate care throughout the school day.

When families promptly submit required forms and notify us of changes in their child's health, medications, or treatment plans, our nursing team can work proactively to prepare for each student's individual needs.

To have every student's healthcare plan in place so they can safely participate in school and enjoy a successful year at Midland!



Health and Wellness Corner: Important Health Documentation



Please return all requested health documentation promptly. Depending on your child's individual healthcare needs, this may include:

General Health Information

- Annual Physical Examination
- Updated Immunization Records
- Medication Administration Forms
- Physician's Orders

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Please Keep Us Updated

It is also important to notify the Nursing Department about any changes to your child's healthcare needs, including:

- ✓ New or updated diagnoses
- ✓ Changes in medications or treatments
- ✓ Updated treatment plans
- ✓ New recommendations from physicians or specialists

Keeping Midland informed helps us review and update your child's healthcare plan as needed.

Important Reminder

Delays in receiving required medical documentation may postpone the implementation of medications, treatments, or specialized medical care until the appropriate physician orders and required documentation have been received.

Our goal is to have every student's healthcare plan finalized before services begin whenever possible so that we can provide the safest, most effective, and individualized care for every student.
